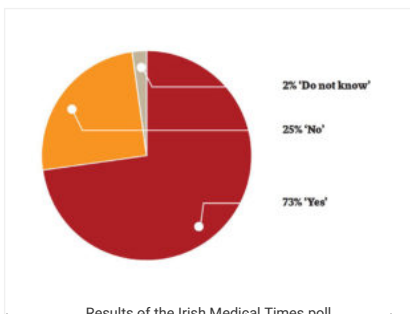
Majority of doctors in Ireland who responded to IMT poll back abortion up to 12 weeks

Some 73 per cent of 388 responders said they agree with abortion up to 12 weeks into pregnancy

The majority of responders to the latest *Irish Medical Times* poll, would, as medical practitioners, support the introduction of abortion on request up to 12 weeks into a pregnancy.

With 388 votes cast, 285 responses (73%) said 'Yes' they would support the introduction of abortion on request up to 12 weeks into a pregnancy, 25% (97) said 'No' they would not support the introduction while 7 (2%) did not know.

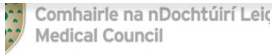
