

# Women on Waves Abortion Reform Protest In Solidarity, In Defiance



**2.30–3.30pm | Tuesday 21 June | Royal Courts of Justice**

Please join us on 21 June as we stand in solidarity and defiance outside the Royal Courts of Justice in Belfast as the Court of Appeal hears the case to declare that the current law relating to access to abortion violates women’s basic human rights.

The protest follows the flight of an abortion pills drone by Women on Waves from Ireland to Northern Ireland – an act of solidarity between women in the south and the north. The flight will occur at Narrow Water at 10am.

Our act of solidarity highlights:

- Existing abortion laws are a violation of human rights
- The law criminalises women
- Abortion pills are available over the internet and are safe when taken as directed by and after a medical consultation with a doctor
